

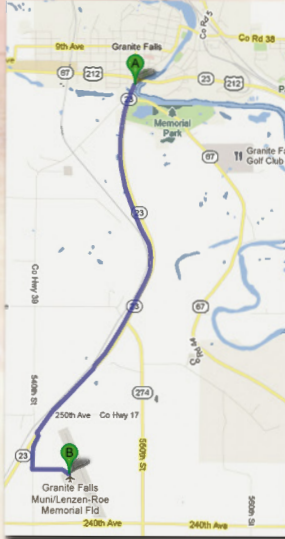

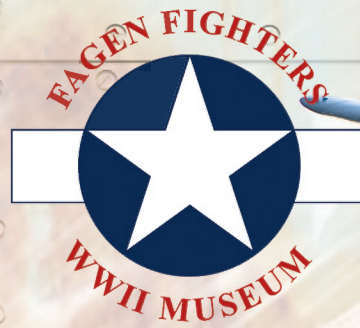

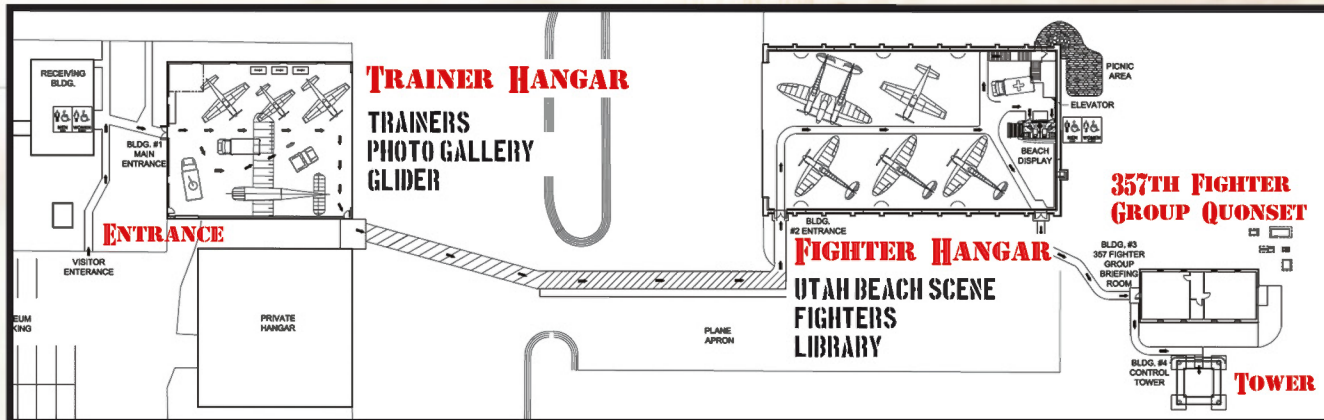
A WORKING FACILITY

Fagen Fighters WWII Museum is dedicated to preserving the legacy of the men, women, and machines that fought and served in the Second World War.

Our museum has the distinction of being one of the few in the world maintaining exhibits that are fully operational and active. On any given day, one may witness a P-51 Mustang roar into the skies or a D-Day Ambulance drive by with siren wailing.
